THE Inverell Hospital will now be the proud owner of a phototherapy unit thanks to the fundraising efforts of Operation Operating Room and the special efforts of Danks/BK Oliver Home Timber and hardware, whose final donation of \$1000 pushed the raised amount over the line to be able to purchase the unit.

The unit will provide babies suffering from jaundice with the support they need in the Inverell Hospital, reducing the need for mothers and babies to have to travel.
